DataWind launches UbiSurfer in Indian market

Mumbai: DataWind Limited, a developer of wireless web access product and services, has launched UbiSurfer, an ultra-portable notebook with Internet connectivity for ubiquitous surfing in the Indian market.

Making online access faster and simpler, the device allows connectivity at the touch of a button and comes bundled with 30-hours per month of free Internet access for the first full year useable across India, a company press release said.

With the UbiSurfer, a user only pays for the device not the usage, the release said, adding for an average user there are no monthly fees, airtime, tariffs, contracts or recurring fees, the release said.

The device is powered by Tata Teleservices' CDMA network across India, it said.
